

# Deflector Directions

## Removing Streetlights

1. Remove the screw assemblies at each end of your Deflector. It is necessary to remove both of them.
2. Take something solid (a piece of dowel or something similar) that will fit inside the Deflector and place it on a hard surface such as a counter.
3. Place the Deflector over the dowel so that you will be pushing the Streetlight out the top.
4. Push down firmly but smoothly while GENTLY twisting the Deflector. This should push the Streetlight out of the top and enable you to replace the batteries or remove it entirely.
5. If this push/twist motion isn't enough, hold the Deflector with one hand and the "pusher" with the other and tap them both against the counter, driving the Streetlight upward with a bit more force. This will usually fix any sticking problems.

## Reinserting Streetlights

1. Lubricate the outside of the Streetlight with a SMALL amount of water, glycerine, or even good old spit. It doesn't take much!
2. Try to push the Streetlight in while gripping the Deflector as gently as possible. A gentle twisting motion will also help.
3. When replacing the screws, BE CAREFUL! The threads are somewhat delicate. If a screw doesn't go back together very easily, back it out and try again.
