

Caring For Your Clear Staff

With proper care, your clear staff should last for many years. Here are some tips to help keep it in good condition.

- ◆ Plugs - Keep the threads clean and remember that these parts are plastic and can be deformed with excess pressure. **DO NOT OVERTIGHTEN!** A good snug fit is sufficient.
- ◆ Avoid excess heat - Your staff is made of a thermoplastic and will soften & bend if you get it too warm. Don't leave your staff in your car on a warm day or store it direct sunlight or near a heat source.
- ◆ Storage - Your staff is made of a flexible material that will bend if not properly stored. Be sure to store your staff either completely upright or lying down where it will be fully supported. You may want to store it in the mailer it came in.

- ◆ Liquids - Your staff will hold water and other liquids as long as the rubber O-rings are in good condition. If your staff begins to leak around the plugs, replace the O-rings. Do not use solvents or other harsh liquids in your staff, and clean it properly after use to avoid residue or mildew.

- ◆ Cleaning - You can clean your staff with soap and water or other household cleaning agents. DO NOT use strong solvents as they may harm the material.

- ◆ Static - If you use Streetlights in your staff, you may find that they mysteriously turn off after a time. This is due to the buildup of static electricity caused by the staff rubbing against your hands. To help correct this problem, wipe the staff down with an anti-static dryer sheet before use. This will prevent static for quite a while and the process can be repeated with no harm to the staff.

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
